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## Tilt – Film Appreciation Society

Tilt, the Film Appreciation Society of Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College, held an orientation session on **4 September 2023** for the 2023–24 session. The orientation featured a detailed presentation highlighting the society's history, goals, and activities.

On **10 September 2023**, Tilt hosted a movie discussion on “**Whiplash**” for college members. The discussion covered aspects such as the film's background, critical reception, cinematography, and score.

Later, on **3 October 2023**, Tilt organized a seminar featuring **Dr. Lalit Shokeen**, a renowned content creator. The session included an interactive Q&A where attendees asked various questions about his professional and personal life.

On **25 October 2023**, Tilt arranged a cinematic discourse on “**Swades**”, delving into the film's themes, cinematic elements, and character dynamics. On **1 November 2023**, Tilt organized a screening of the Hollywood thriller “**Get Out**”, drawing a large crowd of film enthusiasts. This was followed on **28 November 2023** by a cinematic discourse on “**Arrival**”, exploring its take on the science fiction genre.

As part of Tilt's annual film festival held on **15 February 2024**, **Mr. Harshit Bansal**, founder of *Humans of Cinema*, addressed students and encouraged the culture of film appreciation. The festival also featured several events including the murder mystery competition “**Whodunnit**”, a Bollywood quiz, and the open mic event “**Alfaaz**”, which showcased performances by musicians, poets, and comedians before a large audience of Delhi University students.

During **Tamasha**, Tilt organized **Frame Forge**, a video editing competition challenging participants to create short films from provided clips. The society also hosted a screening of “**The Banshees of Inisherin**”, which was well received by the audience.

Tilt's **AFSANA**, a short film competition, provided a platform for student filmmakers nationwide to showcase their creativity and storytelling abilities. The **Cross Character Writing Competition, Inferno**, attracted a diverse range of entries, highlighting participants' narrative skills.

Finally, on **29 February**, Tilt hosted a movie discussion on “**Highway**”, where attendees engaged in a detailed analysis of the film's plot, characters, cinematography, and soundtrack.
