The day is observed to honor the supreme sacrifice of the younger Sahibzadas (sons of Guru Gobind Singh Ji) and to remember their unwavering courage in the face of oppression. Around 47 participants were connected in the programme.

The event commenced with a brief introduction by the Principal, who expressed deep respect and admiration for the bravery of the Sahibzadas, with particular emphasis on the supreme sacrifice made by the younger Sahibzadas, Baba Zorawar Singh and Baba Fateh Singh. The Principal highlighted how, despite their tender age, the Sahibzadas remained steadfast in the face of immense adversity, choosing martyrdom over compromising their values and beliefs. This poignant reflection underscored their unwavering courage and commitment to righteousness. Dr. Baljeet Kaur, convenor of the Minority Cell, who highlighted the significance of the day and the purpose of the commemoration.

Following the Principal's address, a brief video was shared showcasing the heroic saga of the Sahibzadas, shedding light on their incredible strength and unwavering determination. The session also included a short interactive discussion and their poems, where students shared their thoughts on the importance of remembering the heroic tales of the younger Sahibzadas and how these stories continue to inspire generations.

In conclusion, the celebration of Veer Bal Diwas was a poignant reminder of the sacrifices made by the younger Sahibzadas for the cause of righteousness and justice. The session helped to foster a deeper understanding of Sikh history, and the values of bravery, sacrifice, and devotion were instilled in the minds of the students.
