National Cadet Corps (NCC)

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) Unit of Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma (ARSD) College continues to uphold its legacy of discipline, leadership, and service to the nation. Comprising committed cadets from diverse academic backgrounds, the unit actively engages in a wide range of activities including training camps, social service initiatives, and national integration programs. Guided by the motto “Unity and Discipline,” the NCC Unit fosters a spirit of patriotism, responsibility, and teamwork among the students, playing a vital role in their holistic development.

Plantation Drive: The NCC Unit of ARSD College conducted a Plantation Drive to promote environmental awareness. This activity took place on 24th April 2024 with the participation of 20 cadets. Cadets planted saplings like Neem and Ashoka within the college premises and pledged to nurture them. The activity encouraged cadets to take responsibility for preserving nature and emphasized sustainable living.

Group Discussion and Lecture Session: ARSD NCC organised a Group Discussion and Lecture competition under the theme “Save Yamuna, Save Earth.” This session was conducted on 19th May 2024 with 32 cadets participating. The cadets highlighted the importance of saving the Yamuna River and its direct link to saving the planet. Through insightful discussions and speeches, they raised awareness about water conservation, pollution control, and the need for urgent collective action. The event aimed to ignite a sense of responsibility among the youth towards protecting natural resources and ensuring a sustainable future.

International Yoga Day: On the occasion of International Yoga Day, cadets of ARSD College performed various yoga asanas and pranayama exercises under expert guidance. This celebration was held on 21st June 2024 with the active participation of 60 cadets. The session promoted physical fitness, mental peace, and awareness about the importance of yoga in daily life.

Bravehearts Run: On the occasion of Kargil Vijay Diwas, ARSD NCC organised the Bravehearts Run to honour the supreme sacrifice of the Kargil war heroes. The event took place on 26th July 2024 with 80 cadets participating. The cadets participated with pride, remembering the brave soldiers who laid down their lives for the nation. Motivational slogans and chants throughout the run created an atmosphere filled with pride and respect for the martyrs.
