## MINUTES OF THE IQAC MEETING HELD ON 13 JUNE 2017

A meeting of the IQAC was held on 13 June 2017. The following members were present:

The minutes of the meeting held on 25 March 2017 were read and approved.

### A. Action Taken Report

1. The Chairperson reported that the College had entered into two MOUs, one with the National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD), GoI and the other with the (AIFMR) of Financial Markets & Research (AIFMR), in order to offer collaborative courses.
2. In order to accommodate stakeholder feedback, the College website had made available an alumni feedback form in addition to the pre-existing student feedback form.
3. He further reported that McKinsey would be visiting the campus in July to hold a training programme on Soft Skills prior to their pre-placement talk.
4. It was decided that a brochure highlighting institutional facilities would be produced. To this end, the Chairperson informed the Committee that one on the Library was already in the works.
5. The Chairperson also informed the Committee of the two new College Societies that had been formed-the ARSD chapter of Enactus, a global non-profit committed to transforming lives through entrepreneurial action, and Pixelation,

the Photography Society. Both societies would fill a gap in terms of the opportunities available to the student body.

### B. Minutes

1. The Committee offered its congratulations to the Principal and his team for the stellar NIRF ranking and commended their work in this regard.
2. The Committee formally adopted that an application for the College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) grant be submitted.
3. Concern was expressed over the low Perception scores of the College and it was resolved to familiarize all staff with the procedure in order to rectify the situation before next year's rankings.
4. To further enhance the College's reputation for excellence in research, it was decided that faculty members would be requested to register themselves on research portals such as Research Gate, Web of Science, Scopus, and Google Scholar, among others.
5. The need to enhance placement and internship opportunities was raised, as was the need to enhance sports facilities on offer.
6. The Committee remarked on the necessity of conducting more workshops for students focusing on application-based learning.
7. The members also felt the need to focus on the humanities streams of the College, given its strong reputation in the Sciences. Interactive sessions introducing students to well-known contemporary writers, artists, filmmakers and media persons would help open up avenues for alternative career choices.
8. It was also agreed upon that faculty members should be encouraged to apply for research grants, register themselves for PhD, and increase the intake of PhD students in their respective departments.
9. The Committee was of the mind that an interdisciplinary in-house research journal would be the next step in bolstering the academic reputation of the College and the procedure to formalize an external Advisory Board and an Editorial Board were deliberated upon.
10. The Committee suggested that the PhD Chamber of Commerce may be approached to explore opportunities to offer consultancy services to small businesses.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
