The minutes of the meeting held on 13 June 2017 were read and approved.

### A. Action Taken Report

1. The Chairperson was happy to report that the Departments of English, Physics and Hindi had organized one-day Faculty Development Programmes, a concrete beginning towards enhancing faculty research capabilities and deepening the research culture of the institution.
2. The Hindi Department had organized a student workshop on creating narratives and had also organized a "Kavya Goshti," pursuant to the Committee's recommendation to hold more humanities-focused events.
3. The Skill Development and Entrepreneurial Cell had organized a Skill Development Programme in November for teaching and non-teaching staff, titled "Practical Applications of GST," in order to familiarize the staff with the newly-implemented GST measures.
4. The Chairperson was glad to highlight the stellar achievements of Saket Jha, a second year student of Political Science (Hons) who was the only male candidate in the University to be chosen for the prestigious Harvard Crossroads Summer Programme 2017, held in Dubai from 10 to 15 August, 2017.
5. The NSS unit of the College had undertaken two new initiatives in order to expand its ambit of social responsibilities. In July 2017, Connecting Dreams

Foundation—ARSD Chapter was launched and an SDMC Primary School had been adopted as part of the efforts. The Chairperson reported that volunteers were working with the children to fulfill some of their wishes and make them more agile—both mentally and physically. Additionally, since August 2017, the Unit had adopted Sri Ram JJ Camp, a slum near College, in order to improve the living conditions there. In September, the education team of NSS comprising 50 volunteers initiated SEVADEEP, a mission targeted at developing the minds of the slum children.

6. The second edition of the ARSD Youth Conclave had been enormously successful, almost doubling the number of participants and attracting colleges from all over Delhi NCR. The Chairperson was pleased to note that the event had become a part of the College's Annual Calendar and was a much-anticipated event.

5. It was also felt necessary to conduct additional training programs for faculty members.
