### Celebrating 75 Years of Indian Independence

#### Report of the Month of October, November & December

In an endeavour to foster national unity, integrity, patriotism, harmony and a sense of togetherness among its students and faculty, ARSD College of Delhi University took pledge to celebrate the **Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav** until the next Independence Day. ARSD College conducted various activities in the months of October, November & December. On 17<sup>th</sup> October Saarang: The Music Society of the college organized an inter college online solo singing competition on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2021. 29 students were participated in this competition. On 27<sup>th</sup> October IQAC of the college organised a lecture by **Prof Amiya Kumar Bagchi** (Emeritus, Institute of Development Studies, Kolkata) on the theme **Indian Economy Under British Rule**. 147 students and teachers were participated in this webinar. On 28<sup>th</sup> October, the college organised a lecture on the birth anniversary month of **Mahatma Gandhi** by Sh. **Madhukar Upadhyaya** on the theme **Mahatma: The Journalist**. 93 students were participated in this lecture.
