Past, Present and Future of India's Foreign Policy

Prof. Mattoo is a renowned scholar of International Politics and conferred Padamshree in 2008 by the Government of India. The event started with the introductory speech Dr Amit Singh, Convener, Republica. Dr. Singh has talked about the changing dynamics in India's Foreign Policy. He even drew a parallel line between the Prime Minister Narendra Modi & Late Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's foreign policy. Prof. Mattoo in his speech has appreciated Dr. I.M. Jha for giving him the honour to release his book. He said we often use Western Paradigm to understand the global political issues. He countered US "exceptionalism" with India's "exceptionalism". While talking about India's exceptionalism, he supported his argument by discussing about India's democracy. He pointed that all the countries that opted democracy post colonisation, only India, managed to run a successful democracy and related institutions. Prof. Mattoo emphasised that 'the historical accident of great leadership', elaborate Constitution and great Civilizational heritage has played major role in this regard. He later underscored that the exceptional leadership of former Prime Minister Late Indira Gandhi, focusing on an annexation of Sikkim, division of Bangladesh and India's nuclear explosion. The fact that, even after some remarkable achievements, Ms. Gandhi lost the general elections because of imposition of national emergency and the power of Indian democracy. Prof. Mattoo condensed India's foreign policy in three words: space, strength and stability. He praised our foreign policy by putting the fact that India had never become an instrument of any other foreign power. He called the Chinese hegemony in Asia, the biggest threat to India's security. Talking about both internal and external security, he said that "India needs both bomb and bread". In the end, he underscored that Nationalism is best when it is incorporated in the DNA of every individual Indian. The seminar ended with a question and answer session and a vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Charu Mathur.


